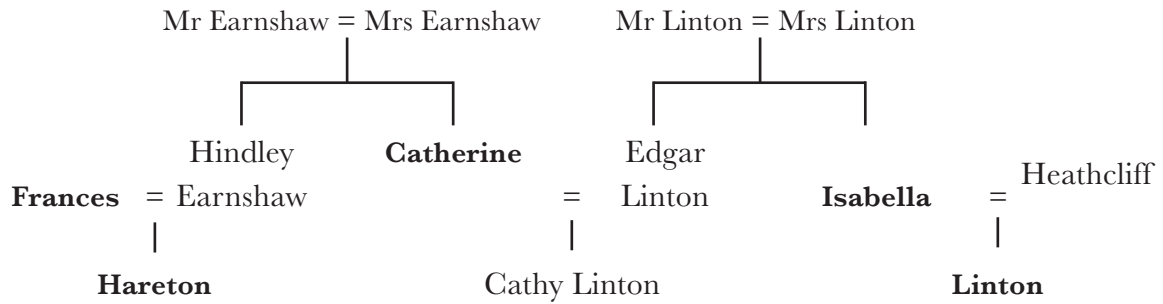


1a Complete the family tree. Use the names in the box.
