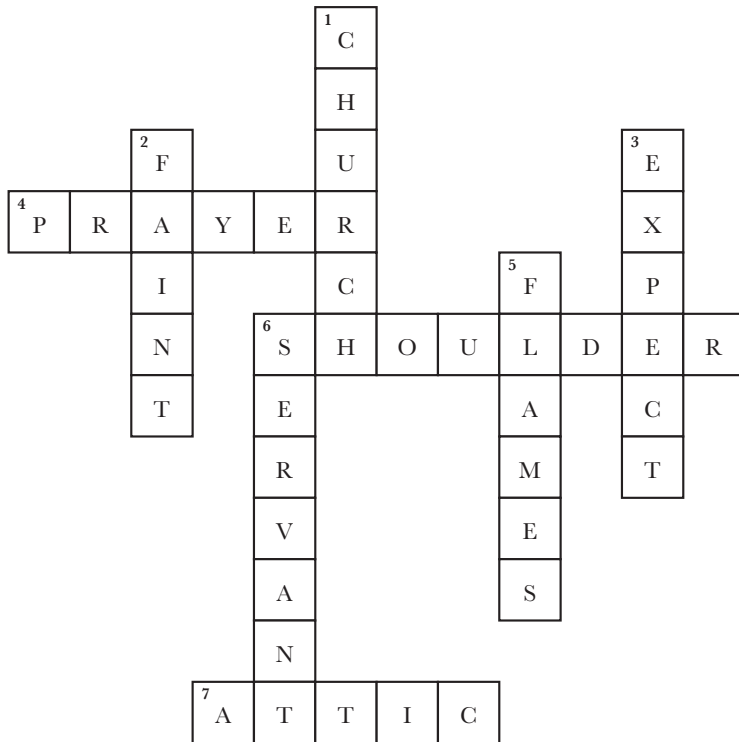

5 **Model answers:**

Jane discovers she has a family.	Jane is taken in by St John, Diana and Mary after walking for days. When Jane's uncle leaves her all of his money, St John realizes that Jane is his cousin. Jane is very happy that she has a family and shares her money with them.
Jane goes to find Mr Rochester.	Jane finds Mr Rochester in a dark room. He is blind but when he touches Jane and hears her voice, he quickly realizes it is her. Jane tells Mr Rochester she will never leave him again and he asks her to marry him. Jane feels happy and very lucky.
