



Auschwitz was a Nazi concentration camp in Poland, which was used during the Second World War from 1940 until 1945. It was a terrible place where lots of <sup>1</sup> ..... were kept. There <sup>2</sup> ..... three camps at Auschwitz: Auschwitz I was for political prisoners from Poland; Auschwitz II <sup>3</sup> ..... used to kill the other prisoners. Around 1.1 million prisoners died at Auschwitz, and most of those killed were <sup>4</sup> ..... The Allies (the USA, Russia, UK, France, China and other countries) did not believe the murders were <sup>5</sup> ..... at first, so they did not do anything about the camps.
