 Captain Nemo is a captain. He is young. He is wearing a hat. His face is sad.

- 3 **Model answer:** My sea animal is very big. Its body is blue and orange. It has ten legs and five eyes. Its big mouth has many teeth. The animal lives in very cold water. Every day, it eats people for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

### After-reading questions

- 1 It is not an animal. It is a submarine.  
 2 The animal kills people.  
 3 Bad people kill Captain Nemo's family and he wants a new home. Captain Nemo does not like people, and he cannot live near them. Captain Nemo makes the *Nautilus* and then he can live in the sea.  
 4 **Model answers:**  
 He is a good man:  
 • He gives money to people.  
 • He helps Professor Aronnax and Ned Land.  
 • He is a good teacher to Professor Aronnax.  
 • He gives the pearls to the man.

He is a bad man:

- He kills people.
- He says that Professor Aronnax and Ned Land cannot go home.
- He takes money.

- 5 Model answer:** Professor Aronnax likes the *Nautilus*. She is happy on it, and she learns a lot. But after ten months, she wants her home.
- 6 Model answer:** Ned Land is not happy on the *Nautilus*. He wants his home, and he does not like Captain Nemo. (But he likes pearls!)
- 7** Captain Nemo has clothes for the sea. They have air in them.
- 8 Model answer:** She likes the *Nautilus*. And now she can sleep.
- 9 Model answer:** The man is not a bad man, and he does not have a lot of money.
- 10 Model answer:** “They are bad people. They are bad to many good people. They are attacking me and now I can stop them.”
- 11 Reader’s own answer.**
- 12** Professor Aronnax goes 20,000 leagues on the *Nautilus*.
