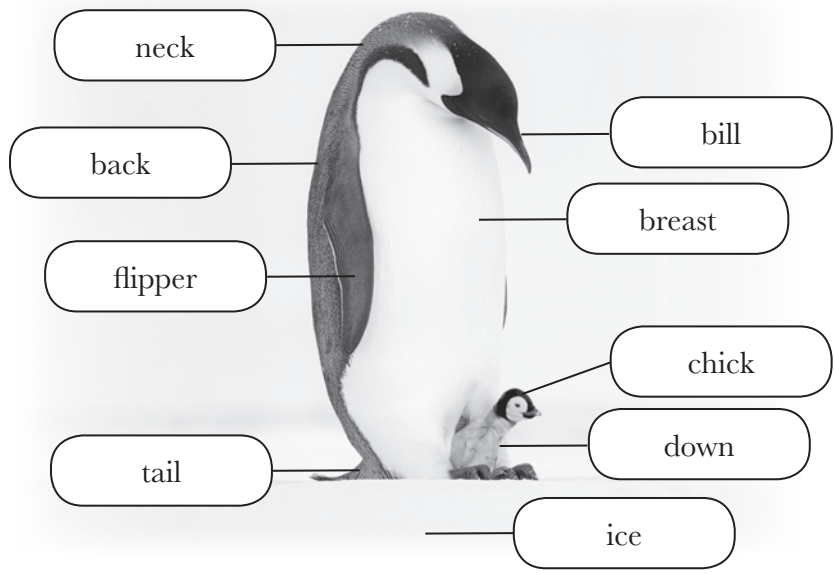
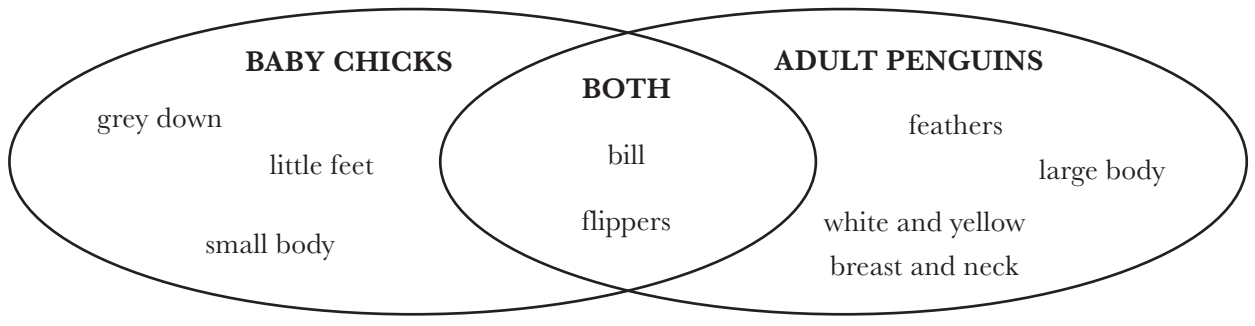

4 **Model answers:**

**April** The male courts the female, and they mate.

**May and June** There is no sun for eight weeks. The female lays her egg and then goes to the sea for food. The male keeps the egg warm on his feet.

**Late July** The female comes back from the sea. Slowly, a little grey chick hatches out of the egg. The female gives it food.

**August** Again and again, the male and then the female go to the sea for food.

**September to November** The chick is bigger. It lives on the ice and not on its parents' feet. The male and the female can go to the sea together and bring back more fish.

**December to March** It is summer. The chick can leave its parents and start a new life.
