

	Marianne and Willoughby	Willoughby meets Marianne for the first time when she falls and hurts her foot.	He carries her home and they fall in love.
	Lots of people at a ball in London	Willoughby avoids talking to or looking at Marianne because he is with Sophia.	Willoughby sends Marianne a letter explaining that he is going to marry Sophia.

Picture	Who is in it?	What is happening?	What happens next?
	Elinor, Edward and Lucy	Edward comes to visit Elinor in London and finds Lucy Steele there.	They are all embarrassed and Elinor leaves the room to give Edward and Lucy a chance to talk.
	Willoughby and Elinor	Willoughby has heard that Marianne is ill and comes to see her.	Willoughby explains to Elinor about his marriage to Sophia and his child with Eliza.
	Edward, Elinor, Marianne and Mrs Dashwood	Edward has come to explain that Lucy Steele has married his sister.	Edward asks Elinor to marry him.

4a *Model answers:*

- 1 It is the letter that Willoughby writes to Marianne after the ball in London. It is important because Sophia makes him write it, because she is jealous and he is going to marry her.
- 2 It is the letter that Lucy writes to Edward explaining why she is going to marry his brother and not him. It makes it possible for Edward to ask Elinor to marry him.
