Before-reading questions

- 1 *Example answer*: King Louis XIII became King of France in 1610, after his father, King Henry IV of France, was murdered. Louis was only eight years old. While he was still a child, Louis's mother, Marie de Medici, ruled with him. Louis married Queen Anne of Austria in 1615, when he was fourteen. (Their son became the very famous King Louis XIV.) Being so young, Louis needed help and advice from other leaders. In the 1620s, the most important of these was Cardinal Richelieu, who was also a priest. (A cardinal is one of the most important positions in the Catholic Church.) Richelieu was fourteen years older than the King, and he was a very intelligent and powerful man.
- 2 Example answer: Gascony is in the south-west corner of France, next to Spain. It is next to mountains and the sea, and it is a long way from Paris. It is a part of the country with lots of villages and farms, and not many big cities. In the 1620s, it was probably much poorer than Paris.
- **3** *Example answer*: The front cover shows the swords of the Three Musketeers, as they make a promise together. They are saying the words "*All for one and one for all*". This means that the whole group should help each person in the group, and each person should do things that help the group.
