

**1 Complete this article about Lithuania with the correct words.**

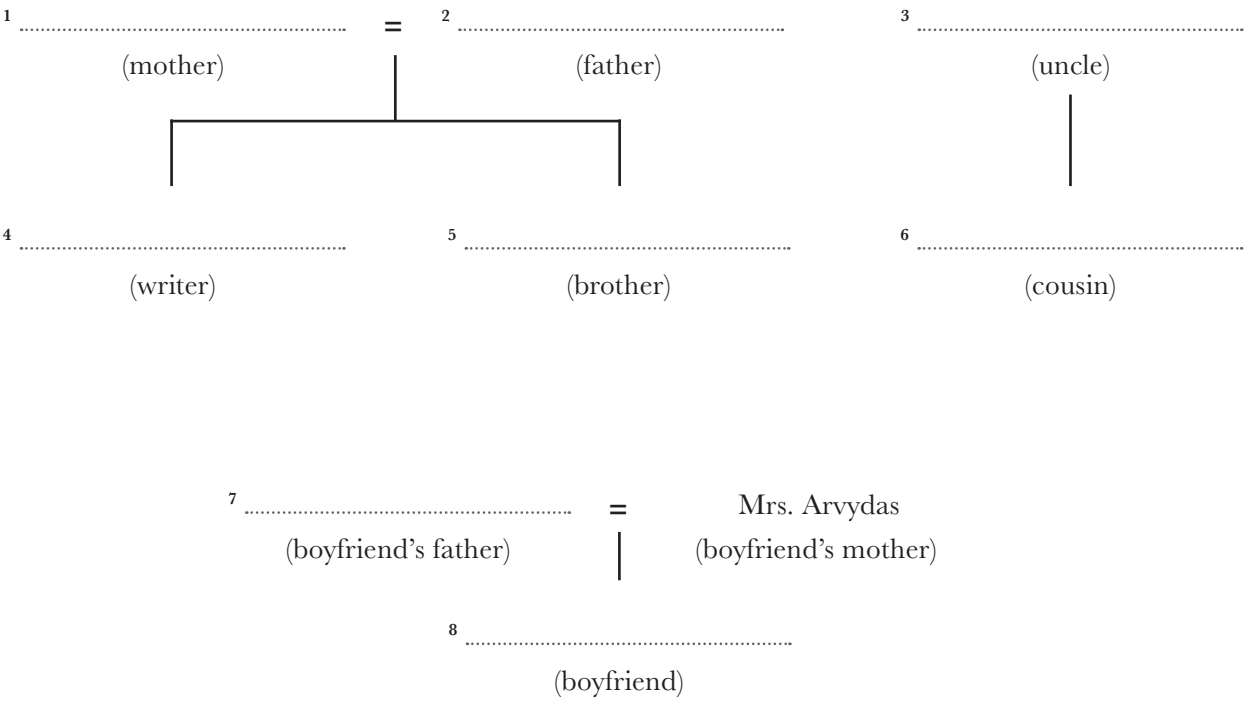
In 1941, Lithuania was part of the <sup>1</sup> *German Reich* / *Soviet Union*, which was ruled by <sup>2</sup> *Adolph Hitler* / *Joseph Stalin*.

At the end of the 1930s, Stalin began a series of purges to deport people who he believed were his <sup>3</sup> *enemies* / *friends*. In Lithuania, around 130,000 people were forced to leave their <sup>4</sup> *homes* / *jobs*. Those who were deported were usually politicians, artists, or <sup>5</sup> *scientists* / *teachers*.






The prisoners were often taken to northern <sup>6</sup> *Siberia* / *Spain*. They were forced to do hard <sup>7</sup> *labor* / *work*. They had to build their own huts as well as buildings for the NKVD officers. Around 28,000 Lithuanians died of starvation, <sup>8</sup> *cold* / *hot* weather, illness, or from beatings by the NKVD. After Stalin's <sup>9</sup> *birth* / *death* in 1953, some Lithuanians were <sup>10</sup> *allowed* / *forced* to go home, but many were not.

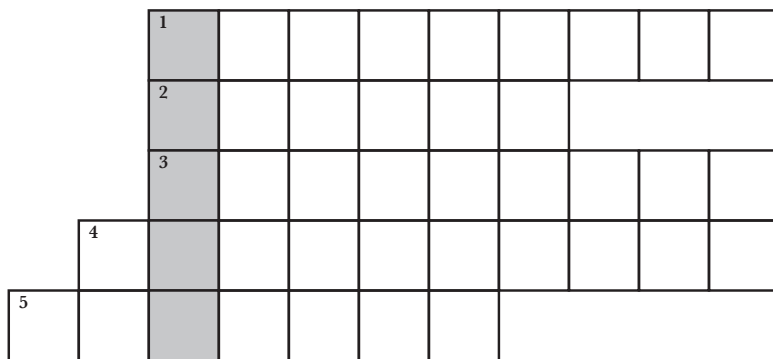
